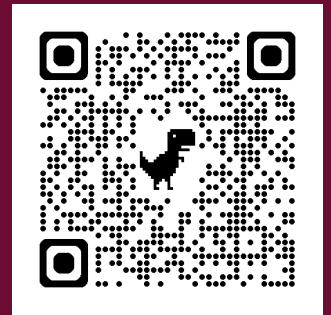

CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT

This position provides routine patient care to promote patient comfort and contribute to the overall patient plan of care.

Minimum Qualifications:

- High school diploma/GED or equivalent working knowledge
- Excellent organizational skills
- Effective human relations and communication skills
- Computer literacy and keyboarding skills
- Current BLS certification. Current C.N.A. license in state of practice may be required in certain facilities and/or departments in accordance with regulatory requirements or facility/department policy.

CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT TRAINEE

The Denali Center CNA Trainee program is intended to provide the skills and knowledge required for students to pass the State of Alaska Certified Nurse Aide exam. The position is temporary in length, for the duration of the program and/or until the student passes the State exam.

- The first 4 weeks at Denali Center, Trainee time will be spent in the classroom.
- 40 hours a week working and training will be the expectation for Trainees.
- All class materials, licensing and application fees related to the CNA course are covered by Foundation Health Partners.
- At the end of the class, CNA Trainees will be ready to sit for the State of Alaska Certified Nurse Aide examination.
- Employment with Denali Center as a CNA for at least a year after certification is expected of participants.
