HIRING

EMERGENCY FIREFIGHTERS IN FAIRBANKS

Recruitment period:
April 1-30, 2026

EFF employment is dependent on fire activity and incident needs. Firefighters are often assigned to work on 20-person hand crews and should be prepared for remote 14–21-day assignments.

Emergency and initial attack firefighters are hired on an as-needed, short-term basis, and utilized to augment the permanent workforce. Emergency firefighters must be at least 18 years of age, have successfully completed initial and recurrent firefighter training, as well as an annual physical fitness test, prior to employment.
