



Dislocated Worker Program Introduction

Thank you for your interest in the WIA Dislocated Worker Program. The Dislocated Worker Program assists workers who are losing their jobs, or have already lost their job due to no fault of their own. This program also covers workers who were self-employed and are unemployed as a result of general economic conditions in the community where you live or because of natural disasters. The goal is to assist workers in returning to full-time suitable work. A range of benefits from this program may include job search assistance, financial assistance to relocate to another job, supportive services for emergencies while in the programs, job training, and weekly needs related payments when in full time training.

Guidelines for the Dislocated Worker Program:

- Applicants work with a Dislocated Worker Program Representative.
- Funding is available for services when applicants meet program eligibility and demonstrate funding needs. Training assistance is provided for full-time jobs in demand in a community where you are willing to live. Job training is generally limited to 104 weeks or less and is intended to return you to full time, self-sustaining employment.
- Program participants must apply for PELL Grants and other sources of grant funding as well as funding offered through the Dislocated Worker Program.

What are the steps to apply?

1. Complete the enclosed Applicant Information form.
2. Contact a Job Center to make an appointment with a Dislocated Worker Program Representative.
3. Bring the attached Applicant Information form or similar information with you to your first appointment with the Dislocated Worker Program Representative.
4. The Dislocated Worker Program Representative will review your work history and determine your eligibility for program services.
5. If you are eligible for the program you will work with the Dislocated Worker Representative to identify employment needs, agree on an employment goal, and together develop an individual employment plan.
